Mr. Musik shines on his debut

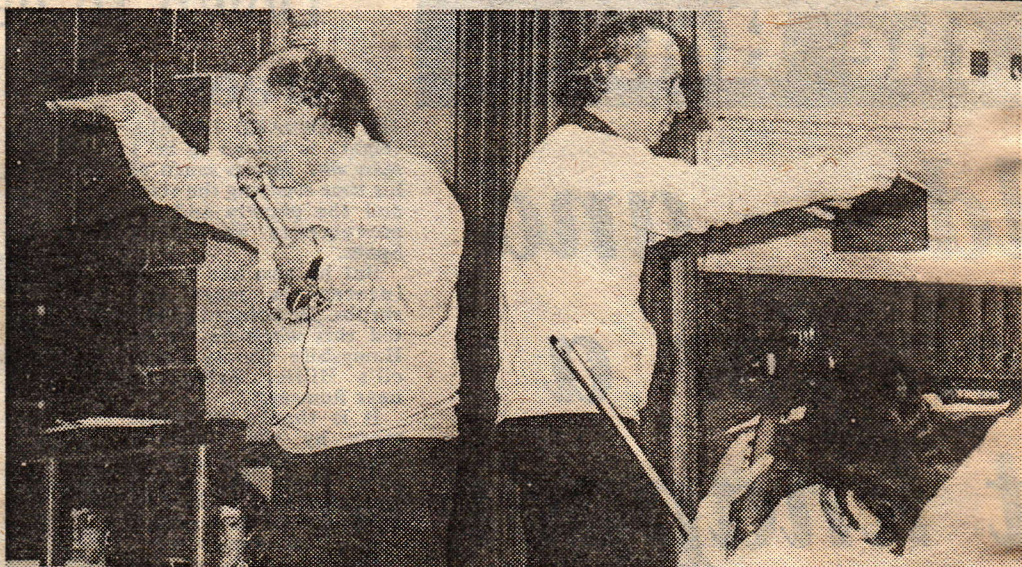
SOUTHAMPTON Youth Orchestra has every reason to be proud of itself — at least according to the Master of the Queen's Musik, Malcolm Williamson.

Mr. Williamson made his first public appearance with the orchestra at Southampton's Guildhall yesterday — after just four days at a practice session together.

"It is a spectacularly good orchestra," he said. "I wouldn't play with them otherwise."

Over 800 children joined the SYO and Mr. Williamson in one of his "cassations" — The Glitter Gang. It is a short relaxation piece where the audience takes parts and the rehearsal becomes the performance.

In the evening, the SYO played with Mr. Williamson for his own Concerto No. 1.
